قائد اعظم محمد علی جناح نے پاکستان کے متعلق فرمایا تھا: دنیا کی کوئی بھی طاقت پاکستان کو دنیا کے نقشے سے نہیں مٹا سکتی۔ قائد اعظم کے اسی فرمان کا لاج رکھنے کے لیے آج تک ہزاروں نہیں لاکھوں جوانوں نے اپنی جوانی ملکِ خداد پاکستان کے لیے وقف کی، اور اپنی جانوں کے نذرانے پیش کئے، انہی میں سے ایک محسنِ پاکستان ڈاکٹر عبد القدیر خان ہیں۔

ان کا نام ڈاکٹر عبد القدیر خان تھا ، ان کے والد کا نام عبد الغفور تھا، ان کی پیدائش یکم اپریل 1936 ہندوستان کے شہر بھوپال میں پیدا ہوئے۔ تقسیمِ ہند کے بعد انہوں نے ہندوستان کو خیر آباد کہہ دیا اور پاکستان کو اپنی

مستقل سکونت بنائی، ابتدائی تعلیم انہوں نے جامعہ کراچی سے حاصل کی، اس کے بعد وہ اعلیٰ تعلیم حاصل کرنے کے لیے یورپ گئے جہاں انہوں نے پندرہ سال رہ کے برلن، ہالینڈ اور بیلجیم کی مختلف یونیورسٹی سے ماسٹرز آف سائنس اور ڈاکٹر آف انجینئری کی اسناد حاصل کیں۔

ہندوستان کے ایٹمی طاقت بننے کے بعد سے پاکستان کی بقاء خطرے میں پڑ چکی تھی، اور یہ خطرہ بڑھنے لگ گیا تھا کہ کسی بھی وقت بھارت پاکستان پر ایٹمی حملہ کر سکتا ہے، انہی حالات کے پیش نظر ڈاکٹر عبدالقدیر خان نے پر تعیش زندگی اور انتہائی اچھی آمدن والی ملازمت کو خیر آباد کہہ کر 1976 میں پاکستان کا رخ کیا

مئی 1976 میں انہوں نے ”انجینئری ریسرچ لیبارٹریز“ کے پاکستانی ایٹمی پروگرام میں حصہ لیا (جس کا نام بعد میں جنرل محمد 31 ضیاء الحق نے ڈاکٹر اے کیو خان ریسرچ لیبارٹریز رکھا) یہ ادارہ پاکستان میں یورینیم کی افزودگی میں نماں مقام رکھتا ہے۔

میں جب بھارت نے دوسری مرتبہ ایٹمی تجربہ کیا تو آپ نے اس وقت کے وزیر اعظم میاں محمد نواز شریف سے 1998 درخواست کی ہم بھی ایٹمی تجربات کرنا چاہتے ہیں، یوں آپ نے چاغی کے مقام پر چھ ایٹمی کامیاب تجربات دھماکہ کر کے پاکستان کو ایٹمی ممالک کی فہرست میں لاکھڑا کیا، اور قائد اعظم کے فرمان کے مطابق پاکستان کو ایک ناقابل تسخیر ملک بنا دیا۔

اسکے بعد مغربی ممالک نے آپ پر جھوٹے مقدمے دائر کئے، جن میں بالآخر آپ کو باعزت بری کیا گیا، لیکن 2000ء میں آپ پر لگنے والے جھوٹے الزامات کی بناء پر آپ کو نظر بند کیا گیا

آپ نے ایک سو پچاس سے زیادہ سائنسی مقالات لکھے، مفتی اعظم پاکستان نے آپ کو اسلامی ہیرو قرار دیا۔

ڈاکٹر عبد القدیر خان 10 اکتوبر 2021 کو پورے عالم اسلام، خصوصاً پاکستانی قوم کو سوگوار کو چھوڑ کر خالق حقیقی سے جا ملے۔ آپ کا نماز جنازہ شاہ فیصل مسجد میں ادا کیا گیا اور فیصل مسجد کے احاطے میں آپ کو دفن کیا گیا۔

ابتدائیہ: شاہ ولی اللہ رحمہ اللہ علیہ 1703ء میں پیدا ہوئے ان کے والد کا نام شاہ عبد الرحیم تھا جو ایک عالم اور مشہور عالم دین تھے آپ نے ابتدائی تعلیم اپنے والد سے حاصل کی جو کہ مدرسہ رحمیہ دہلی میں قرآن و سنت کی تعلیم دیتے تھے۔

نفس: آپ نے سات سال کی عمر میں قرآن مجید حفظ کیا اور پندرہ سال کی عمر میں بیشتر علوم کی تحصیل سے فارغ ہو گئے ، والد کی وفات کے بعد آپ نے مدرسہ رحمیہ میں درس و تدریس کا کام سنبھالا 1732ء میں آپ نے حج کے لیے مکہ تشریف لے گئے، ہلکی حالات کی خرابی کی وجہ سے دوستوں نے آپ کو عرب میں قیام کا مشورہ دیا لیکن آپ اس پر رضامند ہو گئے۔

حضرت شاہ ولی اللہ کا زمانہ مسلمانوں کے زوال کا ابتدائی دور تھا۔ مسلمانوں کی فوج طاقت ختم ہو چکی تھی دہلی اور آگرے تک کا علاقہ جاٹوں کے رحم و کرم پر تھا، شاہ ولی اللہ نے تمام حالات کو بغور مطالعہ کیا اور ان کی بھی اسلام کو برے صغیر میں دوبارہ عروج حاصل ہو۔
