MY FAVOURITE PERSONALITY

The great scholar and military general in the history of Islam, the one known as Sayfullah, means the drawn sword of God, the brave and brazen more solid who feared no one but God, as my favorite personality is HAZRAT KHALID BIN AL WALID R.A.

Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid lived fierce life between 592 and 642 AD. He was born in Makkah. Saudia Arabia: his father was Al Waleed. He was a wealthy chief of one of the villages of Makkah and a trader of the Bani Makhzum clan; it was among the noblest and leading tribe clan of the Quraish. The tribe clan was in charge of war and the training of horses. Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A was taken to a foster mother in the desert so that he would grow up strong and healthy. She took care of him till he was 5 and 6 years then he was returned to his parents.

His father took great pride in his family, taught his son the same. Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A trained furiously at a young age and became an expert swordsman and horseman. He was obsessed with war, when he reached maturity and learned every art of fighting. He was among the best warriors in his tube and the whole Arab. He was as one of the bravest and most successful military commanders.

He gained experience through many years of war by commanding the military forces of PROPHET MUHAMMAD S.A.W, to the Rashidun Caliphate, Hazrat Abu Bakr, and Hazrat Umer Farooq R.A He always got successful in his battles and wars due to his expertise and proficient tactics in the battle fields, he inherited this from his forefathers. He was ingenious in this field. Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A accepted Islam after the treaty of Hudaibiya at around 627. He fought his first battle as a Muslim and was one of the generals in an expedition against the Ghassanite prince who had murdered Muslim enemies. The army force of thirty thousand was commanded by Hazrat Zaid R.A. When Romans and Arabs had joined forces against the Muslims, and Hazart Zaid R.A got martyred alongside Jafar. Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A took command and broke nine swords while he fought relentlessly and courageously. ALLAH knows how many unbelievers Khalid R.A wounded and killed while breaking nine sword. After the parties returned to their encampment at dark, Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A positioned his army in such a way that they looked greater in number. It had created fear into the enemy's heart and fool them into thinking that they had gotten reinforcement overnight. The enemy soldiers were scared and worried when they saw the army and ordered army to attack at once.

Their powerful attack scattered the enemy army, and the magnificent army had to run away, that was the biggest defeat for them. The Prophet S.A.W sent him on many expeditions, including the destruction of the pagan. He went to Yemen to the Banu-al- Harithtrlbr to call them to Islam. One of his bravest acts was in the conquest of Mecca at around 630.

The battle with these people was a challenge for Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A, but he succeeded once again, and there was another victory for him. Hazrat Khalid-bin-Walid R.A later succeeded in many other great expeditions like the battle of Yamaha, around the Muslim world, the invasion of Iraq through the dashing of Persia, and the consequence of Hira. He fought many other battles, such as, the river battle and that of Wajala. He was also congratulated by Hazrat abu Bakar R.A for his success, and was later allowed to Byzantine in Syria where he was supposed to instruct the Islamic armies.

Hazrat Khalid bin Walid is one of the greatest, strategical, respected, and honored Islamic expansionists. He was believed to be a prominent assistant of the Prophet Muhammad S.A.W.

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








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
