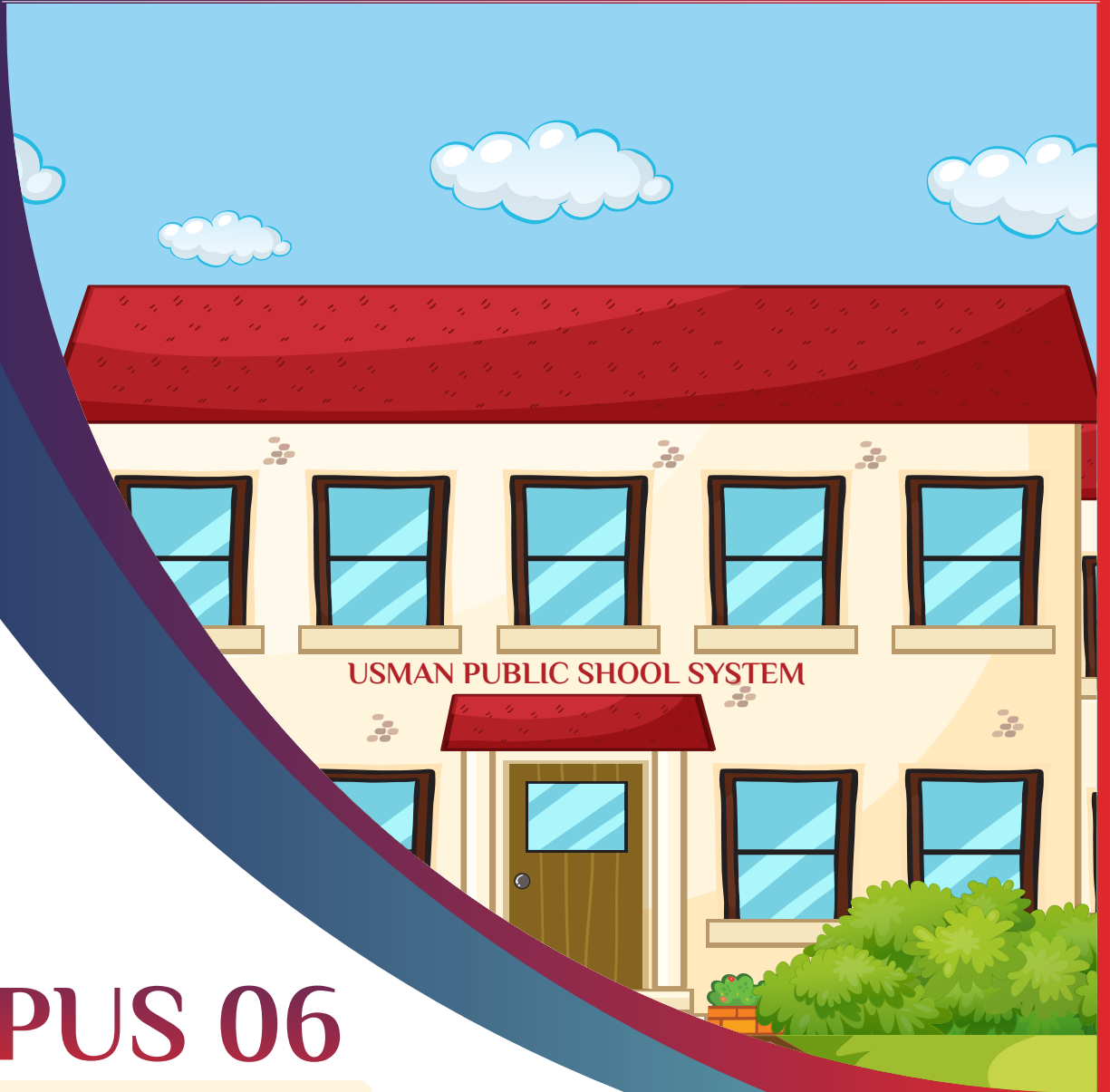

All-purpose flour—1 cup

Oil ——— 1/2 cup

Baking powder ——— 1 teaspoon

Cocoa powder ——— 1/3 cup

Powdered sugar 3/4 cup

Coffee ——— 1/2 teaspoon

Water ——— 2 or 3 tablespoon

Eggs ——— 2

Salt (optional) ——— 1 pinch

Butter (to brush onto the cake pan) As required

Method

**Step 1:** Add all the ingredients in a dry bowl.

**Step 2:** Combine all the other ingredients and make a smooth and fluffy batter.

(Addition of salt is optional)

**Step 3:** Preheat the oven 180 degrees. Take a cake pan at least 2 inches tall, grease it well inside of the pan with softened butter and sprinkle some flour on it.(You can also use butter paper).

**Step 4:** Pour the batter into the prepared pan.

**Step 5:** Bake the cake for about 30 minutes ( half an hour) and insert a knife or toothpick into the cake to check whether the cake is done or not. If it comes out clean then the cake is ready.

**Step 6:** Remove it from the oven.
