PARENTING AND ISLAM

Parenting is not just a responsibility—it's a sacred journey, a profound act of love, and a trust placed in our hands by Allah. It's about more than providing food, shelter, or education; it's about nurturing a soul, shaping a heart, and guiding a life toward its greater purpose. In Islam, this role is a divine gift, one that carries immense blessings and challenges. It's a journey that demands patience, wisdom, and an unshakable reliance on Allah's guidance. The Quran and the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) are our compass, illuminating the path to raising children who are not only successful in this world but also deeply connected to their Creator.

Every parent dreams of raising children who are righteous, compassionate, and strong in faith. But let's be honest—parenting is hard. It's messy, exhausting, and often overwhelming. There are moments of joy that make your heart swell with pride and moments of frustration that bring you to your knees. In those moments, we turn to Allah, just as Prophet Zakariya (peace be upon him) did, with a heartfelt plea:

رَبِّ هَبْ لِي مِنْ لَدُنْكَ ذُرِّيَّةً طَيِّبَةً إِنَّكَ سَمِيعُ الدُّعَاءِ

"My Lord, grant me from Yourself a good offspring. Indeed, You are the Hearer of supplication." **(Surah Al-Imran, 3:38)**

Every parent dreams of raising children who are righteous, compassionate, and strong in faith. But let's be honest—parenting is hard. It's messy, exhausting, and often overwhelming. There are moments of joy that make your heart swell with pride and moments of frustration that bring you to your knees. In those moments, we turn to Allah, just as Prophet Zakariya (peace be upon him) did, with a heartfelt plea:

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا كُونُوا قَوَّامِينَ بِالْقِسْطِ شُهَدَاءَ لِلَّهِ وَلَوْ عَلَىٰ أَنْفُسِكُمْ أَوِ الْوَالِدِينَ وَالْأَقْرَبِينَ

"O you who have believed, be persistently standing firm in justice, witnesses for Allah, even if it be against yourselves or parents and relatives." **(Surah An-Nisa, 4:135)**

Favoritism, whether subtle or overt, can wound a child's heart and sow seeds of resentment. But fairness—treating each child with love, attention, and respect—builds a home filled with trust and security. It tells them, "You matter. You are valued."

Yet, as parents, we often forget that our children are watching us more than they are listening to us. They absorb our actions, our words, and even our silences. The Quran poses a piercing question:

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا لِمَ تَقُولُونَ مَا لَا تَفْعَلُونَ * كَبُرَ مَقْتًا عِنْدَ اللَّهِ أَنْ تَقُولُوا مَا لَا تَفْعَلُونَ

"O you who have believed, why do you say what you do not do? Great is hatred in the sight of Allah that you say what you do not do." **(Surah As-Saff, 61:2-3)**

If we want our children to be honest, we must be truthful. If we want them to be patient, we must show patience. If we want them to be kind, we must embody kindness. Our actions speak louder than our words, and our children are always listening, even when we think they're not.

And then there's love—the foundation of it all. The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) was a beautiful example of love and tenderness toward children. He would kiss them, hug them, and play with them. His affection wasn't hidden or reserved; it was open and abundant. He understood what modern science now confirms: children who feel loved and valued grow into confident, emotionally healthy individuals. A home filled with warmth, encouragement, and affection is a sanctuary where a child's heart can flourish.

But love isn't just about hugs and kisses it's also about communication. The Quran teaches us:

قُولُوا لِلنَّاسِ حُسْنًا

"And speak to people good [words]." **(Surah Al-Baqarah, 2:83)**

Harsh words, raised voices, or dismissing a child's feelings can create walls between us. But gentle words, active listening, and validating their emotions build bridges. It tells them, "I see you. I hear you. You are important to me."

Of course, parenting isn't just about emotional nurturing, it's also about spiritual guidance. The greatest gift we can give our children is faith. Teaching them about Allah, prayer, and the beauty of a righteous life lays the foundation for their moral and spiritual growth. The wisdom of Luqman, as shared in the Quran, is a timeless example:

وَإِذْ قَالَ لُقْمَانُ لِابْنِهِ وَهُوَ يَعِظُهُ يَا بُنَيَّ لَا تُشْرِكْ بِاللَّهِ إِنَّ الشِّرْكَ لَظُلْمٌ عَظِيمٌ

"And [mention, O Muhammad], when Luqman said to his son while he was instructing him, 'O my son, do not associate [anything] with Allah. Indeed, association [with Him] is great injustice.'

(Surah Luqman, 31:13)

Instilling the love of Allah in our children gives them a compass for life a sense of purpose, inner peace, and resilience in the face of challenges.

Yet, let's not sugarcoat it parenting is hard. There will be moments when your patience wears thin, when your child's defiance feels like a personal failure, when you wonder if you're doing enough. In those moments, remember the Quran's reminder:

كَاطْمِينَ الْغَيْظِ وَالْعَافِينَ عَنِ النَّاسِ وَاللَّهُ يُحِبُّ الْمُحْسِنِينَ

"And those who restrain anger and pardon the people and Allah loves the doers of good."

(Surah Al-Imran, 3:134)

Discipline is necessary, but it should come from a place of love, not anger. It's about guiding, not punishing. It's about teaching, not breaking. And through it all, we must encourage curiosity and independent thinking. The Quran constantly urges us to reflect, question, and seek knowledge. A home where children feel safe to ask questions, express their thoughts, and explore their faith is a home where their hearts and minds can grow together.

Parenting is not about perfection it's about sincerity. It's about showing up, day after day, with love, patience, and trust in Allah. It's about making dua, pouring your heart out to Him, and knowing that He is the ultimate Guide. The Quran captures this beautifully:

بَنَّا هَبْ لَنَا مِنْ أَزْوَاجِنَا وَذُرِّيَّاتِنَا قُرَّةَ أَعْيُنٍ وَاجْعَلْنَا لِلْمُتَّقِينَ إِمَامًا

"Our Lord, grant us from among our wives and offspring comfort to our eyes and make us an example for the righteous" **(Surah Al-Furqan, 25:74)**

This is the dua of every parent's plea for children who are a source of joy, a reflection of faith, and a legacy of goodness. Parenting is a journey of growth, not just for our children but for us as well. It's a journey filled with tears, laughter, mistakes, and countless moments of gratitude. And through it all, we hold onto one truth: with Allah's help, we can raise children who shine with His light, in this world and the hereafter.
